Career Molding Apprenticeship

Program: Offers hands-on real world experience and interaction and on the job training.

Identifies several pathways of growth while learning through an individualized experiential program.

Each student is provided with trajectory centered opportunities for education within a specific profession.

Below view the diverse selection of career tracks and the responsibilities associated with each, available for students to choose from.

Each position is connected to a specialized field of work within the FHL Missional Community that will provide a different experience conducive to the vocation pathway selected by the student. The following career tracks are housed within the FHL Community Career Molding Apprenticeship.

Students will review each role and the associated responsibilities and select the best option based on their level of interest.

BtH Division Position: Beyond this Hunger Corporate Trainer Apprenticeship

A Trainer that is focused on educating individuals within corporate settings about how to connect to their team and overall corporate vision. The 16 week course delves into principles that create an understanding around how to train others with content and activities that increase self leadership, that educate on team values, and superior stress management modalities.

<u>United Food Missions Position</u>: Community Development and Outreach Apprenticeship A Community Development Specialist that will learn entry level strategic planning, community analysis, needs assessments, and informatics. The position will also learn what the ability to raise awareness on the needs does for funders of community development initiatives.

FHL Academy Life and Leadership Position: Relationship Builder Apprenticeship An engagement specialist that understands the nature and importance of building relationships.

Thoughtfully establishes community relationships with the mind set of partnership as an end result. Offering solutions and empowerment for communities.

FHL Community Inc. Marketing Arts Position: Digital Design Coordinator Apprenticeship Provides creative advice and development of visual content for marketing concepts. Curates designs for websites, products, content, programs or digital platforms for any FHL Community divisions. Including Missional Food Pantries, United Food Missions, FHL Academy or Life & Leadership School.

Students who are interested in enrolling in the Career Molder Apprenticeship Program must be at least a sophomore in high school and complete the following enrollment requirements.
